- 2. Pledge of Allegiance
- 3. Approve Minutes from 1/21 Cox made the motion, Lott 2nd, unanimously approved.
- 4. Approve Agenda Cox made the motion, Lewis 2nd, unanimously approved.

OLD BUSINESS

- 5. **Dog kennels -** description attached. Estimated total to complete the project is \$4,000-\$4,500. Lott made the motion to approve the amount, Jones 2nd, unanimously approved.
- 6. City limits clarification Geter expressed his concern of the change of the city limit line. There were citizens that once could have voted in the city elections and now they can't. Cox and Carrillo expressed that it was done in late 2016 to early 2017 and it's .75 miles from the center of town. R. Clark expressed that legislation set the boundaries possibly 40-50 years ago and there would be a process if changed.

- 8. Swing set at walking track children wooden swing set was taking down due to rotten wood. CM Floyd presented council with a swing set from Home Depot for \$2,021. Cox made a motion to grant Floyd permission to spend \$2500 or less on a new swing set, Lott 2nd, unanimously approved.
- 9. New City Hall discussion a new city hall has been brought up a few times, but Floyd would like to know in what direction would the council want him to go in getting quotes. Rather to fix what they have, repair the old pharmacy, or tear down and rebuild. The council stated that they would possibly start some work sessions to discuss the city hall.
- 10. City Administrator Report Floyd gave his report from 1/22 until 2/17. Report is attached.

- 12. Police Report Report attached. For the month of January, the PD answer approx. 218 calls, issued 22 citations and done 8 reports. Need a new radar in new Tahoe. Have had the radar since

1986. Cox made a motion to get the new radar with warranty for \$1625, Lott 2nd, unanimously approved.
