Would like add names of the veterans from Wheeler that served in war after the Persian War which are the Iraq and Afghanistan Wars. Have had others to say that they have had family serve in war but not sure of the criteria to get added. There are still questions how it's going to be funded and where the names will be placed possible on the back. Will get with American Legion to see if there are any rules on who can be added.
  - There are 2 Bradford pear trees that are taking over the flag poles and not sure how they can be trimmed to look right. They might have to be removed because they are messing up the marble on the monument but are not sure what they can be replaced with. School FFA is looking to donate some trees to plant through the city.
